LABAROMETER LONGITUDINAL DATASET DESCRIPTION & CODEBOOK



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## 1. INTRODUCTION

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This document describes the LABarometer (LAB) Longitudinal Dataset of the Understanding America Study (UAS), which was created at the University of Southern California's Center for Economic and Social Research (CESR). Support for this data collection was provided by MUFG Union Bank and CESR. The LAB is a biannual (formerly quarterly) internet-based survey of approximately 1,800 Los Angeles County residents. The survey monitors social conditions and attitudes related to livability, mobility, sustainability, and affordability in Los Angeles County. This project was reviewed and approved by the USC IRB (UP-14-00148).

LAB participants are members of the UAS internet panel (<https://uasdata.usc.edu>) who reside in Los Angeles County. The UAS is a nationally representative panel of American households randomly recruited from United States Postal Service delivery sequence files. UAS members are adults aged 18 or older who agree to answer surveys, on average, once or twice monthly via an online interface.

The UAS LAB Longitudinal Dataset includes the first and second waves of LAB surveys, or eight surveys total, fielded from July 19, 2019, to January 9, 2022. Each survey wave comprises four LAB surveys, fielded three to six months apart: Livability, Mobility, Sustainability, and Affordability.<sup>1</sup> Participants were invited to complete LAB surveys due to their residency in Los Angeles County. Participants who responded to at least one question of one of the surveys fielded by LAB are included in the LAB Longitudinal Dataset.

The LAB Longitudinal Dataset can be linked with any UAS survey not already included. How to perform that linkage is described later in this document. Available data from the UAS LAB is listed on the UAS LAB page. An updated listing of all available UAS data sets is available on the [UAS All Surveys page](#).

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<sup>1</sup>In its third wave, LABarometer moved to a biannual survey frequency. Four surveys were combined and reduced in size to two surveys: Livability & Affordability, Mobility & Sustainability. The third wave will be added to the UAS LAB Longitudinal Dataset in Spring 2023.

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## 2. OVERVIEW OF THE UAS LAB LONGITUDINAL DATASET

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### 2.1 UAS Input Files

The LAB Longitudinal Dataset consists of survey responses to two waves of LAB surveys. The dataset is structured based on survey wave. A “wave” consists of a full sequence of all four LAB surveys (Livability, Mobility, Sustainability, and Affordability). The dataset is constructed as a participant – wave level dataset. Each row corresponds to a wave where a participant contributed survey responses to at least one survey that was part of that wave.

In each participant – wave row are survey responses to each survey question fielded in that wave. Which survey a question was part of is indicated by a suffix at the end of the variable. The suffix `_liv` indicates that the question was asked as part of the Livability survey, the suffix `_mob` indicates that the question was asked as part of the Mobility survey, the suffix `_sus` indicates that the question was asked as part of the Sustainability survey, and the suffix `_aff` indicates that the question was asked as part of the Affordability survey.

The LAB Longitudinal Dataset contains 3,450 observations (participant – waves). Response rates and observations for each individual survey included in the dataset can be found below:

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In addition to responses to LAB surveys, each participant – prompt row contains participant information related to the timing and date of the LAB survey and demographic and other variables taken from the respondent’s latest MyHousehold survey that was completed prior to

the corresponding LAB survey. Information on demographic variables included in the dataset can be found in the [MyHousehold Codebook](#).<sup>2</sup> Demographic and other variables taken from the MyHousehold Survey are time-varying across both surveys and waves.

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## 2.2 Obtaining the UAS LAB Longitudinal Dataset

The UAS LAB Longitudinal Dataset is available for download in STATA format from the [UAS website](#). If you would like the data in a different format, such as SAS, please email your request to [uas-l@mymaillists.usc.edu](mailto:uas-l@mymaillists.usc.edu).

Before accessing the UAS LAB Longitudinal Dataset or other UAS data, one must first obtain permission by registering on the UAS site to download the UAS public release files. Registering with UAS is considered agreeing to the “conditions of use” governing access and usage of the data.

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## 2.3 Merging with other UAS Data Sets

Each UAS file is merged with other files using the unique person identifier variable, *uasid*. This variable, assigned to a participant at recruitment into the UAS panel, stays fixed for each survey taken. For more information about default identification variables included in each survey, such as household identifier, *uashhid*, please visit the [UAS standard variables page](#).

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<sup>2</sup> The My Household survey is administered quarterly to all participants. To provide background information about the participant and household, the survey asks about key demographics, including age, ethnicity, education, marital status, work status, state of residence, and family structure.

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### 3. VARIABLES

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For the purposes of this codebook, variables are grouped into three content groups: (1) identifying and metadata variables and (2) participant answers to the corresponding LAB survey questions and (3) demographic variables taken from the most recent MyHousehold Survey the respondent completed prior to the corresponding LAB survey (further information on demographic variables can be found in the MyHousehold Codebook).

Some variables have undergone changes between the administration of LAB survey waves. In the tables that follow, superscripts next to variable names indicate a change in the administration, question wording, or response choices between waves. Each superscript present in the table is explained at the bottom of the table.

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#### 3.1 Identifying and Metadata Variables

##### 3.1.1 UAS Standard Identifying Variables

Three identifier variables are included in the UAS LAB Longitudinal Dataset that are standard UAS Standard Variables. 1) Each participant is uniquely identified with `uasid`. The `uasid` is assigned to a participant at recruitment into the UAS panel, stays fixed across surveys and is the key for linking this dataset to any other UAS file. 2) Households are identified with `uashhid` (original household identifier), which also stays fixed, and 3) `survhhid` (survey-specific identifier), uniquely identifies the household a panel member belongs to at the time of a given survey, and thus can change for participants if they change households (e.g. after divorce).

##### 3.1.2 UAS Standard Metadata Variables

The UAS LAB Longitudinal Dataset contains variables describing when the corresponding LAB survey was started and ended (`start_date`, `end_date`, `start_year`, `end_year`, etc.). Versions of these variables with affixed with the suffix to indicate which LAB survey they correspond to.

##### 3.1.3 LAB Metadata Variables

Beyond standard UAS identifying and metadata variables, the LAB Longitudinal Dataset contains metadata related specifically to the LABarometer panel. There are four “flag” variables that indicate whether the participant answered that survey type in the corresponding wave. Additionally, there are four “panel” variables that range, indicating how many of that survey type the individual has completed during their entire time in the panel.

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### 3.2 LAB Survey Variables

#### 3.2.1 Livability Survey

The LABarometer Livability Survey asks participants to assess the quality of life in their neighborhood within Los Angeles County. The survey asks residents about their happiness, health, safety, social connection, and their access to goods and services. The first Livability Survey was fielded from July 19, 2019 to September 30, 2019. The second wave of the survey was fielded from November 9, 2020 to January 7, 2021. Keywords for specific topics covered in the survey are listed below:

### 3.2.2 Mobility Survey

The LABarometer Mobility Survey primarily concerns transportation patterns, costs, experiences, and preferences among participants in Los Angeles County. The first wave of the survey was fielded from December 11, 2019 to February 7, 2020. The second wave was fielded from March 2, 2021 to April 30, 2021. Keywords for topics covered in the mobility survey are listed below:

Keywords: Transportation, housing, neighborhood, health, home, location, future, car, ride hailing, taxi, public, human powered, electric, scooter/bike/skateboard, skateboard/scooter, motorcycle, amenities, cost, parking, time, safety, height, weight, diabetes, behavior, social, bike, bus, Metro, Metrolink, Amtrak, Dial-A-Ride, walk, scooter, insurance, gas, quality, ethics, skateboard, moped, limo, affordability, accident, harassment, Covid, support, accessibility, environment, and sexual.

### 3.2.3 Sustainability and Resiliency

The LABarometer Sustainability and Resiliency Survey (Sustainability Survey for short), assess the attitudes, knowledge, and behaviors of LA County residents with respect to sustainable practices in their home and neighborhood. Broad areas of coverage include environmental awareness, disaster preparedness, and personal adaptations to climate change. The first Sustainability Survey was fielded from June 3, 2020 to July 13, 2020. The second wave of the survey was fielded from July 19 2021 to September 5, 2021. ### 3.2.4 Affordability and Prosperity

The LABarometer Affordability and Prosperity Survey (Affordability Survey for short) focuses primarily on the financial well-being of participants in LA County. The survey asks participants about their financial health, their spending habits, financial and social hardships, and economic and social changes in their neighborhoods. The first wave of the Affordability Survey was fielded from September 30, 2020 to November 1, 2020. The second wave of the Affordability Survey was fielded from October 14, 2021 to January 9, 2022. Keywords for topics covered in the survey are listed below:
