National Poll - UAS 197, Pre-July-Debate release among Democratic Primary Voters

Field dates: July 12 – July 25, 2019

Sample sizes and MOSE: Release is among our sample of 1,827 Democratic primary voters who participated during these field dates in a national poll of eligible voters. The sample includes 1,520 who also participated in UAS poll 175, in April 2019. Margin of sampling error is +/-3 (at the 98% confidence level). A release of additional questions among the full sample of all eligible voters is scheduled for mid-August 2019.

Sample sizes and margins of sampling error for banner subgroups are provided in the bottom two rows of each table.
