About the 2020 USC Dornsife Daybreak Post-Election Poll

The USC Dornsife Daybreak 2020 Tracking Poll and Post- Election Poll are the result of a collaboration between researchers in two USC research Centers: the Center for the Political Future and the Center for Economic and Social Research, both in the Dana and David Dornsife College of Letters, Arts and Sciences. Some of the questions in the tracking survey (social circle and state estimates) were developed in collaboration with researchers from the Santa Fe Institute and MIT.

The analysis associated with this release is based on the post-election poll (UAS 318), conducted from November 4 to 15, 2020 among 6,285 adult U.S. residents who are active members of CESR's Understanding America Study (UAS) probability-based internet panel. The poll includes 5,978 eligible voters, and 5,102 who voted in the presidential election. Other important subgroups include those who voted early by dropping off ballots (n=1,050) or filling them out at an early voting location (n=994), voted by mail (n=1,856), or voted on election day, either by dropping off a ballot, or filling one in at a voting location (n=1,280). The sample also includes 5,521 who participated in the tracking survey. The poll's margin of sampling error[†] is +/- 1 for all presidential election voters. Margins of sampling error for subgroups may be higher; these are provided in this crosstab release.

The poll took an average of 16 minutes to complete, and participants were paid a nominal fee for participation.

Survey Weights and Participation Rate: As 8,660 panel members were eligible to participate in this survey, the participation rate was 70%. We calculated weights in two stages: (1) base weights account for the probabilities of selection in our sampling procedures, and (2) post-stratification weights align survey distributions to CPS benchmarks and the election outcome. Weighting benchmarks were derived from the Current Population Survey Annual Social and Economic Supplement, as well as from vote estimates provided by the Associated Press and the Cook Report, as of Monday November 16, 2020. As votes are still being counted at the time of this release, final vote margin may be somewhat different. *Due to the panel's sample design, unweighted subgroup sizes may not be representative of the weighted proportion in our variable estimates. [†] Survey Error: Factors other than sampling error may affect results of any survey, including question wording, question order, mode or sample type (e.g. opt-in panels vs. probability panels such as UAS), population coverage, impact of current events, and differential participation decisions by subgroups of respondents. In addition, results of questions asked in an internet panel may obtain different results compared to similar questions asked by other polling firms using phone interviewers. Sampling error calculations are at the 98% confidence level.

About the Understanding America Study Internet Panel

The Understanding America Study (UAS) is an ongoing national research panel that started in 2014. We recruit study members in waves using household addresses obtained from Marketing Systems Group frames which cover all zip codes in the United States. To ensure full coverage of the U.S. population, we provide internet-connected tablets to households that were not already online. Our panel includes U.S. residents who have cell phones, landlines, or no phone at all. Study members are compensated for their participation.
